WHAT

Commodity Food Items such As:

- canned fruits and vegetables • dried beans •
- pasta products • fruit juice • milk • cheese •
- meat/poultry/fish • eggs • rice/grits/cereal •

WHO

Nevada Residents with an Income Less Than 185% of the Federal Poverty Guideline* and/or who receive SNAP, WIC, TANF, SSI, or Free or Reduced Lunch

*If you have a voucher to the food closet - you are eligible to receive TEFAP

WHERE

WHEN

**Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and
Friday from 12:30 to 4:00 pm**

HOW

- Make sure you meet the income guidelines mentioned on this flyer (Not sure? Contact the Food Closet)
 - At the Food Closet, sign the TEFAP form stating you meet the income requirements, be prepared to leave your name, address, and signature
 - Come to the Food Closet once each month to receive this additional box of food items
 - If you are a Food Closet client, you may pick up TEFAP items on your BME fill, Monthly fill, or you can come just for TEFAP foods
 - If you need to have someone pick up TEFAP for you, you MUST fill out an "Authorized Representative" form to put on file before anyone can pick up TEFAP for your household.
